Today's meeting started with the brief recapitulation of the main points of deliberations of the previous meeting held on 30 Sept., 2019. Meanwhile, many programs were organized in the college were succinctly discussed or analysed in the meeting.

- (01) On 1 Oct., 2019, a programme entitled "Careers in Banking Sector & Government Sector" was organised in the college to aware students or guide them for future prospects. 84 students participated enthusiastically in the programme.

- (02) 'Alumni Meet' was organized on 8 Nov., 19 and the chief guest of the Meet was Major General Danand Singh Rawat.

- (03) As per the scheme of the Government of India 'ITS ITC EXAC 2020' 50 students of our college along with two faculty members Dr. S. K. Padaleya and Dr. Mahesh Kumar enrolled for 'Exchange Program' on 31 Dec., 2019. Under this program, they are supposed to visit the Hasan College, Bengaluru.

(Q4) Government of Uttarakhand organised a 'Job Fair' in college campus on 23-24 Jan, 2020. Under the guidance of Ms. Gauravni (Employment Officer) and Mr. Manta Chauhan (Regional Director) at least 4163 candidates registered themselves through portal and 392 candidates get selected by the companies.

(Q5) On 24 Jan, 2020 Mathematics dept. organised a program in collaboration with UGC-CSR. The title of the program was "Core topics of Mathematics". The main speaker of the program was Bhattacharya awardee, Prof. Kishore Venkata (IISc, Bangalore) who was accompanied by Prof. E.K. Narayanan (IISc, Bangalore) and Prof. Sanjay Pant (DU, Deen Dayal Upadhyay College). They imparted valuable insights to students in the subject in interactive manner.

(Q6) A 'Book Fair' was organized in college library from 27 Jan. to 29 Jan. 2020, in which more than 10 publishing houses took part and all departments of the college placed their orders.

(07) A career counselling seminar was organised on 4 Feb., 2020 under the title "How to set Goals of Career". More than 91 students participated in the programme and guided by Ms. Atul K. Gopal (JIM, Kolkata) and Ms. Nikhil Chawla. (NMIMS, Mumbai).

(08) To sensitize students regarding the preservation of rich cultural heritage of Uttarakhand, Deptt. of English and Deptt. of History organized a program on 7 Feb., 2020. Prof. DR Preshit (Former Prof. and Head, Deptt. of English Modern European and other Foreign Languages) currently (National Fellow IAS, Shanta) and Dr. Sanjay Panday (Asstt. Prof. Deptt. of Music) were invited for extensive talk on the topic.

Students participated in the program and submitted / documented their experiences/ feedbacks to the organizing department.

(09) English Department took the initiative of setting up video library, under which the system has been set up and the first movie which will be shown to college students on 15 Feb. 2020, titled Oscar winning movie

'Gandhi' directed by the world renowned director Sir Richard Attenborough.

(10) Inauguration of Heritage Gallery developed by Deptt. of History.
Actions to be taken:

- To start a certificate course in 'Art & Design Centre'.
- To upload a Facebook page (Alumni) on website as suggested by Suneel Chanda Badhani (Alumni Representative).
- A meeting on IPR will be held shortly.
- Regarding the indexing of research papers a workshop will be organized very soon by JNTU.
- Students' Union Representatives put forth their suggestions at ~~the~~ to start new courses like Music and Theatre at graduation level in Arts and B.Com course. On their suggestion, it was decided in the meeting that more musical instruments will be purchased. As far as the demand of more courses and shortage of faculty was concerned, they were

informed or made aware of the government process / rule regarding appointment of faculty and beginning of new courses in the college.

- To procure information regarding the placement of students, verification record should be maintained meticulously as suggested by B.S. Bocht. This issue led to ponder to other members that a kind of mechanism should be developed (unless the requisite information is entered (information regarding placement should be included in TC/CC) the process remain incomplete etc.
- MOU will be signed with Barrackpore Engineering College shortly. Suresh Chandra Badhani appreciated the sincere efforts of Principal V. A. Bawali and all members of staff (teaching & non-teaching) due to which many programs related to or regarding career counselling could be conducted. He affirmed his view that employability is very important factor to assess the success of institution.

Regarding the query of Dr. J. J. Saval (Alumni Representative) related to eligibility criteria of the students selected by companies, Dr. V.S. Savat apprised that college

provided online data to companies; subsequently exam is conducted by companies and the selection process included interaction with the student.

Finally Prof. A.K. Gupta thanked all members of AOTS, specially Dr. J.D. Jena and Cineel Badhani for sparing their valuable time for the meeting & for providing very useful inputs for the betterment of the college.
