With the formal welcome of our guest, Dr. J. S. Senwal (Alumni Rep.) and with a note of punctuality and time management by Principal Sir, the meeting started. Sir apprised all the members of IDAC about the first achievement of the session 2017-18 that online admission process was completed successfully. The challenges and the suggestions taken up in the meeting are as follows:

- (01) To get success in life, not only at individual level but also at professional level, the skill of time management is main mantra. Through various illustrations, Principal Sir emphasized on the punctuality and time management.
- ALTER (02) As discussed in the last meeting that Board would be more effective by inclusion of other members, Sir suggested that the inclusion of members should be voluntary.
- (03) To arrange a lecture on 'Net Banking' and 'Self-efficacy' by Shri V. S. Kalaria and Shri Gaurind Lather.
- (04) Opening of the account of Alumni was termed as the topmost priority of the meeting.

- (05) Here installation of cameras should not be the concern of administration but the proper functioning of all cameras in the institution should be the prime aim as suggested by Dr. J. D. Sena.
- (06) To ^{make} strengthen the 'Swachta Abhiyaan' more effective, students would be the part of it. They should be sensitized about cleanliness by faculty. //
- (07) To aware students about plagiarism and its ill-effects, the initiative can be taken up from U.G. level. As Dr. D. Singh raised the problem and issue of plagiarism in the research field.
- (08) Sir emphasized on the need of involvement of faculty in major and minor projects.
- (09) To resolve the problem of furniture as raised by Dr. A. P. Singh, Sir informed that the order for more furniture has already been placed.
- (10) To handle ~~stdd~~ (non-returning of books after passing out) attitude of students, they should not be given no dues from office without consulting the library. Library 'no dues' would be mandatory. It

would resolve the issue of scarcity of books in library.

- (11) To qualify the parameters of scholarship in its just way, the submission of the certificate of annual income along with the income certificate will be made compulsory at the time of admission as suggested by Dr. V.S. Ramesh.
 - (12) Sitting space would be created for research scholars as pointed out by Dr. Rajeshwar.
 - (13) Dr. Pachauri informed that many foundations and schools like Wipro, IIS etc. are approaching for placement.
 - (14) Principal Sir shared a ~~new~~ idea that the husband of late Dr. Seema Saxena had deposited the amount of 50,000/- in the form of FDR to Botany Dept. The scholarship will be given to meritorious students of Botany in memory of madam Dr. Seema Saxena.
 - (15) KIOSK would be purchased for Central Library.
 - (16) In the issue of 'exclusive classrooms', Sir emphasized on the learner centred teaching rather than teacher centred.
- Sir apprised all the faculty members about the National Seminar of Mathematics

Department on 5, 6 and 7 October, 2017. To meet the challenge of the successful completion of the seminar, Sir motivated all the faculty members and called ^{them} up for their contribution.
